The Fruit of The Spirit, Part 3

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. (Gal 5:22-23 KJV)

The term joy is constantly in equated with happiness today's society. In actuality it does not mean happiness at all. In the Greek, joy means to have a calm delight. How does joy differ from happiness?

Happiness is temporary and is dependant upon situations and circumstances in our lives. Someone may say they are happy with their new car, however a few years from now, if not a few months, they will be unhappy with their car. Their emotions have waned because the car no longer has that "new car smell". They start only see the little things that make the car seem terrible. They become obsessed about it and no longer are happy with their car. This scenario plays out in various aspects of life.

Joy, on the other hand, is



not something that just goes away for a truly born again Christian. Joy is that complete peace God gives us when our lives are falling apart around us and there is no hope. It does not mean we are not a little worried and are not relying on our brothers and sisters in Christ to pray for us and help us. It means that on the inside of us, we are truly sure that it will work out alright because God is in control. It is to be delighted in God's magnificence and His work in our lives, knowing that as Romans 8:28 states, "... all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Being in a sense of calmness is the true work of the fruit of Joy in our lives.

Have you experienced true joy throughout your life? I know that for a long time

whenever something in my life would not go as planned, I was over anxious to the point that it caused health problems. I would seem to be alright on the outside, but on the inside I was not. I was believer and yet I couldn't find this true joy. I realized that it is a result of having a truly intimate relationship with Christ, a dynamic prayer life and a true study of His word while asking for joy to be made manifest in me. How can you get true joy over situations and circumstances in your life when the need arises? Ask Him for it. God made it simple, just ask in true sincerity of heart with every new situation to have the fruit of joy be manifested in your heart. Don't believe? Just try it and see.

We will continue to have church services as usual. Pastor Joseph Kramer will be given our sermons while the Mission Team is away, in Pastor Carl's absence.


Wednesday Night Bible Study...
