***Come to church with
an unselfish attitude.***

If we come to church selfishly, to be entertained and to seek a blessing we have missed the whole point of worship. Worship is giving, not getting...giving God Praise by adoring Him and expressing to Him the worth and value He has in our life. We come to worship service to give God glory and to express our love to Him, not to get blessed. As one man expressed it, the issue isn't, did I get anything out of the worship service? But did I, from the heart, GIVE GLORY TO GOD? Since blessings come from God in response to worship, if you aren't blessed it isn't usually because of

poor music or preaching, but because of a selfish heart that does not give glory to God.

***Come to the worship
service with a
prepared heart.***

Ask God to speak to you as you focus on Him. Come to Church ready to express your praise and love to the Lord.

***Pray for every part
of the service.***

Pray for the music ministry, the scripture readings, the offering. Pray for the anointing of the Holy Spirit for the Pastor in the ministry of God's Word. Pray for those around you, that the Holy Spirit will speak to them and that the Lord would be honored as we worship Him together.

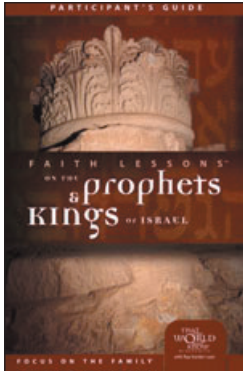
***Pay very close attention

*Reach out to others
who are in the worship
service.*

Ask God to lead you to others who need spiritual council or other help from you. As it says in Hebrews 10:24-25, "Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward

love and good. Let us not give up meeting together, but let us encourage one another."

*Refuse to let distractions
or wandering thoughts
pull your attention and
concentration away
from the living God and
his word.*

Focus on Him and Him only.
