FBC was asked to assume Disaster Relief (DR) response ministry at Main Street Baptist Church Hattiesburg, Mississippi.

Fritz Wilson, FBC DR Coordinator, mobilized FBC's DR response teams on Monday for mass feeding, clean up and recovery and additional DR response as needed.

The team arrived Tuesday night and began feeding operations today in Hattiesburg to assist the Mississippi Baptist Convention in this monumental task.

Dr. John Sullivan authorized funding assistance for Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama Baptist Con-

We are seeing what you see via television and news reports.

Immediate needs for volunteers are not known at this moment.

Where to take supplies, food, water etc. is not known. If we had 10,000 tractor-trailer loads of supplies the logistics of warehousing and distribution are impossible for the time being.

Full information regarding needs and required supplies will be provided to you as soon as we receive more information. The situation is overwhelming. It is the greatest single disaster in US history. Everything possible is being done to bring relief. More will be known as to response needs in a few days.

I am told that there are literally hundreds of refugees from the storm who are in Florida. Churches are caring for many of them. I am tracking and determining what must be done with those coming to us with little hope of a soon return to their homes.

The greatest needs:

Volunteers: Call the Florida Baptist Convention (1-800-226-8584, ext. 3121), the North American Mission Board (770-410-6000), the Mississippi Baptist Convention (601-292-3201), the Louisiana Baptist Convention (318-448-3402), the Alabama Baptist Convention (334-288-2460) and let them know you are available.

Money: The Florida Baptist Convention has set up a "HURRICANE KATRINA" relief account. Donations will be used for hurricane victim relief. Contributions can be sent to the Florida Baptist Convention, P.O. Box 5579, Jacksonville, FL 32247 or individual donations can be made on-line at www.flbaptist.org.
