## "Great Job Sonrise, On Operation Harvest!"



As we look back at the first ever Operation Harvest, I want to point out a couple of danger zones. The whole purpose of Operation Harvest is to take the gospel to the neighborhoods and to people who won't necessarily come to us. While we are there, we also are to try to direct them to a good church to attend. While we are going to them on their turf, so to speak, we need to watch and see how Jesus handled that.

### RELATE-INABILITY

*Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, that behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. (Matthew 9:10)*

This is a verse that I have heard many people use who want to excuse their desire for sin in the disguise of "relatability." Quite often you might hear, "Well, Jesus hung out with sinners. He was met right where they were. So why can't I do the same for my unsaved buddies at the local bar? Come to think of it, those waitresses seem so lonely. If only I could show them God's love and..." Stop it!!!! Jesus was willing to relate to sinners, but watch what He did after He used relatability to establish a relationship with them:

*And when the Pharisees saw it, they said to His disciples, "Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" When Jesus heard that, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick... For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance." (Matthew 9:11-13 NKJV)*

Notice that Jesus didn't just "pal around" with sinners and tax collectors. He didn't settle down and get comfortable with where they were at. Instead, Christ called sinners out of their lifestyle and into an attitude of repentance. He was willing to relate to sinners, but He was also effective in changing sinners into believers who changed their ways.

We need to follow Christ's example and use our relatability

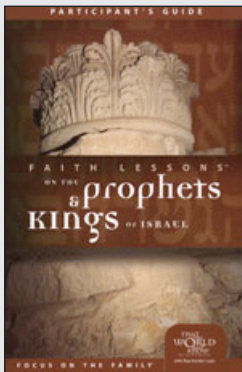

## **Men’s Breakfast and Bible Study**

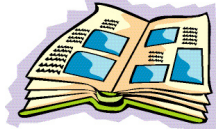
The men also be meet the second Saturday of the month for their monthly Men’s Breakfast. Locations change so stay tuned for where the next breakfast will be held.
