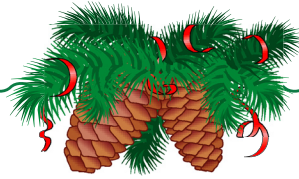

## Navajo Christmas Boxes 2005

We will once again be creating Christmas Shoeboxes for the Navajos in Arizona. We have actual names and information on each child that will be getting a box. See Tina after church to pick a name (or a few) to make boxes for. We have 45 kids total. All boxes must be turned in by Sunday, December 11th in order to mail them in time.

When filling your box please keep in mind age appropriate items. If you are including toys or items that need batteries to run, please include the batteries, as these are luxuries that the Navajos don't have readily available.

To create a box, pick male or female, and one of the age categories from the list provided.

You can decorate your box or wrap it (just be sure to wrap the lid separately, so we can get into it if needed - do NOT seal the box closed). Please also put \$5.00 inside the box to help pay for shipping. Due to the area the reservation is on, UPS shipping is not available, so the boxes must be sent via regular postal service, which can get quite expensive.

Dollar stores and discount stores are great places to get gifts for the boxes and some ideas for inclusion in them include:

Hair Brushes  
Combs  
Toothbrushes & Toothpaste  
Books  
Coloring Books & Crayons  
School Supplies (pens, pencils, notebook paper,  
spiral notebooks)  
Batteries (AA, C, D, 9 Volt)  
Anything else you can think of!



Remember they do not have electricity on the reservation, so do not get things that require electric. Send batteries with things that require batteries. If you are including liquid gifts (such as hand soap or shampoo) please put it in a ziploc bag so that it doesn't leak onto anything if it should break or the top comes loose.
