Foundations is a fresh, innovative curriculum about the essential truths of the Christian faith and how these truths are to be lived out – in your relationships, your character, and your work. Rather than just teaching doctrinal knowledge, this course shows you how to apply biblical truths and implement them in your everyday life.
